

## TRINITY IN THE BIBLE

The Bible reveals a triune Godhead or God. Here, I present a number of verses which support this claim:

**In Genesis 1:1-3**, we read:

“In the beginning **GOD** (Hebrew plural/ Elohim: Gods) created the heaven and the earth. And the earth was without form, and void; and darkness *was* upon the face of the deep. And the **SPIRIT OF GOD** moved upon the face of the waters. And God **SAID** (the Word), Let there be light: and there was light.”

From the above, we understand that there is a **plurality** in God: One God, One Essence, One Being, One Creator, Three Persons who share the same essence and Godhood: God, **the Creator** of all things (Genesis 1:1) who, in Isaiah 63:16 is also called **Father**, His life giving **Spirit**, **the Creator** of Job 33:4, and His living and powerfully working **Word** (Hebrews 4:12,13), **the Creator** of all things (John 1:1-3; Colossians 1:16; Hebrews 1:8,10), who, at the appointed time became flesh (John 1:1,14). This is the reason, in Genesis 1:26 we hear God saying, “let **US** make man in **OUR** image”, in the plural tense, in Genesis 3:22, we hear God saying, “The man has become as **ONE OF US**”, and in Isaiah 6:8, God asks, “who will go **FOR US**?” The Psalmist confirms that our observation is correct, because in Psalms 33:6, he wrote,

“Through the **WORD** of **JEHOVAH** the heavens were made; and all their host *were made* by **THE BREATH OF HIS MOUTH** .”

In the above verse, we see again **the plurality of the Creator God**. We observe:

- 1) **Jehovah**,
- 2) **His Word**, and
- 3) **The Breath of His Mouth**, which refers to **His Holy Spirit**: Ruach/Spirit/Wind.

How can we confirm that the “**Breath**” of God refers to His **Holy Spirit**? Let us read the following verses:

### **Genesis 2:7**

“And Jehovah God formed the man *out of* dust from the ground, and **BLEW** into his nostrils **THE BREATH OF LIFE**; and man became a living soul.” (Please compare with Job 33:4 below.)

### **John 20:22**

“And saying this, He (Jesus) **BREATHED** on *them* and said to them, Receive *the* **HOLY SPIRIT.**”

### **Acts 2:2,4**

“<sup>2</sup>And suddenly a sound came out of the heaven, as being borne along by a violent **WIND!** And it filled all the house where they were sitting ...<sup>4</sup>And they were all filled of **THE HOLY SPIRIT**, and began to speak in other languages, as **THE SPIRIT** gave *ability* to them to speak.”

### **Job 33:4**

“**THE SPIRIT OF GOD** made me, and **THE BREATH OF THE ALMIGHTY** gives me life.”

How can we prove that “**the Word of God**” and “**God’s Spirit**” are **Persons**, and of the Godhead **YHWH**? Let us examine one Person at a time:

### **THE HOLY SPIRIT**

Here we will confirm that **God’s Holy Spirit is a Person** and not just an “**active force**” like electricity, without **will** and **logic**, as some sects claim. I am astonished that some people believe that the Spirit of God **is not a Person**, when they read Scriptures such as the following:

“And while they were doing service to the Lord, and fasting, **THE HOLY SPIRIT SAID**, ... separate both Barnabas and Saul **TO ME**, for the work to which **I HAVE CALLED THEM**” (Acts 13:2).

The words “**to Me**” and “**I have called them**” show that the Holy Spirit is a Person! After all, a “force” like electricity, cannot even speak!

I am astounded that they believe the Holy Spirit does not have a **will**, when they read 1 Corinthians 12:11. There, the apostle Paul says,

“But the one and the same **SPIRIT** works all these things, distributing separately **AS HE WILLS.**”

These words reveal that **the Holy Spirit has a will! Therefore, he is a Person!** A “force” like electricity, does not have a will because **it does not even have a mind!** I am astonished that they believe the Holy Spirit is simply an “active force” **without logic**, when the Bible contains scriptures such as the following:

“For **IT SEEMED GOOD** to the Holy Spirit and to us” (Acts 15:28).

“but the Comforter, the Holy Spirit ... **HE SHALL TEACH YOU** all things, and shall **REMIND YOU** of all things that I said to you.” (John 14:26).

“But when that One comes, the Spirit of truth, **HE WILL GUIDE YOU** into all truth;” (John 16:13).

“**HE** (the Spirit of truth) **WILL ANNOUNCE** the coming things to you. **HE WILL GLORIFY**

ME ...” (John 16:13,14).

“And likewise the Spirit also joins in to help our weakness. For we do not know what we should pray for as we ought, but the Spirit Himself pleads our case for us with groanings that cannot be uttered. But the One searching the hearts knows what is **THE MIND OF THE SPIRIT**, because **HE INTERCEDES** for the saints according to God” (Romans 8:26,27).

“... for the Spirit **SEARCHES** all things, **EVEN THE DEEP THINGS OF GOD** ... so also no one has known the things of God except the Spirit of God.” (1 Corinthians 2:10,11).

From the above Scriptures, it is plain that since Jesus called the Holy Spirit “**He**” (John 14:26 and 16:13,14; Greek “ἐκεῖνος” [ekeinos: masculine gender] = “**he**” --- **not** “**it**”), and as the Holy Spirit can “**teach**”, “**remind**”, “**guide**”, “**announce the coming things**” and “**glorifies**”, “**helps**”, “**pleads our case**”, “**searches all things**” and “**knows the deep things of God**”, the Holy Spirit is a Person who possesses logic!

**The doctrine which insults the Holy Spirit and presents Him as an energy which is impersonal and without brains (no logic), blasphemes against Him (Matthew 12:31; John 16:13,14)!**

Now, let us examine the Scriptures to prove that **THE WORD** of God is also a **Person and One of the True Godhead YHWH**.

### **THE WORD**

The Greek word for “word” is “**λόγος**” (logos). “Logos” is the oral expression of a thought (including the thought), in other words, it refers to **reasoning** (the mental faculty), to **logic**, to **intelligence or wisdom** (Proverbs 8:22-30; 1 Corinthians 1:24). Also, it refers to one’s ability to **express** his/her thought.

The **Logos (the Word of God)** existed from the very beginning of the **intelligent God’s** existence (John 1:1 [was]). **The intelligent God always had the Word in Him** because God was **never** without thought, without the ability to think and to express His thought. The separation between God and His Word is an absolute impossibility, just as it is impossible for one to separate a mind from its own thought!

God is the only uncreated Being. When God thought to create the universe, **HE SPOKE it** into existence. For instance, when God thought to create light, **He expressed His thought** when He said, “**Let there be light!**”; **and the Almighty Word (Logos) of God created light!** Nothing came into existence without God’s Word (John 1:1,2). And **the Word, the Creator of all things**, created everything **for Himself** (Colossians 1:16).

**Is “THE WORD” a Person?** Let us read Hebrews 4:12,13. There, it says,

“For **THE WORD OF GOD IS LIVING AND POWERFULLY WORKING**, and sharper than every two-edged sword, and piercing as far as *the* division of both soul and spirit, of both joints and

marrow, and **ABLE TO JUDGE OF THE THOUGHTS** and intentions of the heart; and there is no creature unrevealed before HIM; but all things *are* naked and laid open to **HIS EYES, with WHOM IS OUR ACCOUNT.**”

Therefore, “**THE WORD**” IS A PERSON, He is the Creator God, One of the True Godhead **YHWH!** The apostle John declares that it was the Word who became flesh, and we know Him as “Jesus”, who, according to the Scriptures, is **THE ONLY BEGOTTEN** (Greek: ‘**μονογενής**’ [monogene]) **SON OF GOD** (John 1:1,14; 3:16). The word “monogene” in Greek means that this Son is **THE ONLY ONE WHO WAS BORN OF THE FATHER** --- not the only one who was “**created**” by the Father, as some people claim. Therefore, this Son is God by nature because only God can come out of God, as only human can come out of a human!

Now, although in Genesis 1:1 we observed that **GOD** created the heaven and the earth, and in Isaiah 44:24 God says He created the heavens **ALONE, BY HIMSELF**, Job 26:13 and Psalms 104:30 tell us that **THE SPIRIT** of God also created, and John 1:3,10, Colossians 1:16, and Hebrews 1:8-10 tell us that it was **THE SON** who created all things! Surely the Creator God is only One --- not three! This is the reason, we believe in One Triune Creator God, the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit, as it is revealed in the Scriptures!

**Q.** Can we trace down more scriptures from both, the Old and the New Testaments, that reveal the Trinity of God?

**A.** Of course we can! Let us review a few. **Isaiah 48:12-16** is fascinating! There, we read:

“<sup>12</sup>Listen to Me, O Jacob, and Israel **MY** called: **I am He; I am the FIRST; surely I am the LAST.** <sup>13</sup>My hand surely founded earth, and My right hand has stretched out the heavens; I called to them, they stood up together. <sup>14</sup>All of you gather and hear: Who among them has declared these *things*? Jehovah has loved him. He will do His pleasure on Babylon; yea, His arm *shall be* on the Chaldeans. <sup>15</sup>**I, I HAVE SPOKEN;** yea, I have called him, I brought him, and he causes his way to prosper. <sup>16</sup>Come near to Me; hear this: I have not spoken in secret from the beginning. From its being, **I WAS THERE;** and now **THE LORD JEHOVAH, AND HIS SPIRIT, HAS SENT ME.**”

Who is the Speaker here? Definitely, it is **JEHOVAH!** And yet, in verse 16, **JEHOVAH** says that **THE LORD JEHOVAH AND HIS SPIRIT HAS SENT HIM!!!** Who was this **JEHOVAH** who was **SENT** by the other **TWO**? Do you see the Trinity here?

In **Zechariah 2:8-11**, we read:

“<sup>8</sup>For **SO SAYS JEHOVAH OF HOSTS: HE HAS SENT ME AFTER GLORY,** to the nations who plundered you; for he who touches you touches the pupil of His eye. <sup>9</sup>For, behold, I will shake My hand over them, and they shall be a prize for their servants. And **YOU SHALL KNOW THAT JEHOVAH HAS SENT ME.** <sup>10</sup>Sing and rejoice, O daughter of Zion. For, lo, **I COME; AND I WILL DWELL AMONG YOU, SAYS JEHOVAH.** <sup>11</sup>And many nations shall be joined to Jehovah in that day, and **THEY SHALL BE MY PEOPLE. AND I WILL DWELL AMONG YOU; AND YOU SHALL KNOW THAT JEHOVAH OF HOSTS HAS SENT ME TO YOU.**”

In the above verses, who was this Jehovah who was **SENT** by the Jehovah of Hosts? The answer is: **JESUS IS THE JEHOVAH WHO WAS SENT BY THE JEHOVAH OF HOSTS**. This statement is supported by Matthew 10:40 and John 3:17. Let us read these verses:

**Matthew 10:40**

“The *one* receiving you receives Me, and the *one* receiving Me receives **HIM WHO SENT ME.**”

**John 3:17**

“For God did not **SEND HIS SON** into the world that He might judge the world, but that the world might be saved through Him.”

In **2 Samuel 23:1-3**, we observe that it mentions **GOD**, the **SPIRIT OF GOD**, and **HIS WORD**. Let us read these verses:

“<sup>1</sup>And these *are* the last words of David, the saying of David the son of Jesse, and the saying of the man raised on high, the anointed of the **GOD** of Jacob, and the sweet singer of Israel: <sup>2</sup>The **SPIRIT OF JEHOVAH** has spoken by me, and His **WORD** *is* on my tongue. <sup>3</sup>**THE GOD OF ISRAEL SAID, THE ROCK OF ISRAEL SPOKE TO ME**: One ruling over man righteously, who rules *in* the fear of God,”

From the above verses we learn that **THE SPIRIT OF JEHOVAH** who spoke through David, is **THE GOD AND THE ROCK OF ISRAEL!** (Please compare with 2 Corinthians 3:17).

**Isaiah 63:7-16**, speaks of **THE FATHER** (verse 16), the **ANGEL OF HIS FACE** (verse 9), and **THE SPIRIT OF JEHOVAH** (verses 10,14). Let us read these verses:

“<sup>7</sup>I will mention the mercies of **JEHOVAH**, the praises of Jehovah, according to all that Jehovah has benefited us, and the great good to the house of Israel, *by* which He benefited them according to His mercies, and according to the multitude of His loving-kindness. <sup>8</sup>For He said, Surely they *are* My people, sons that do not lie, and He is their Savior. <sup>9</sup>In all their affliction, He *was* not a foe; and **THE ANGEL OF HIS FACE** saved them. In His love and in His pity He redeemed them. And He bore them up, and lifted them up all the days of old. <sup>10</sup>But they rebelled, and provoked **HIS HOLY SPIRIT**, so He was turned *to be* their enemy; He fought against them. <sup>11</sup>Then His people remembered the days past *of* Moses *and* His people, *saying*, Where *is* He who brought us up from the sea with the shepherd of His flock. Where *is* He who put His Holy Spirit within him; <sup>12</sup>who led them by Moses' right hand, with His glorious arm, dividing the water before them, to make for Him an everlasting name? <sup>13</sup>He led them through the deeps; like the horse in the wilderness, they did not stumble. <sup>14</sup>As the cattle go down into the valley, *so* **THE SPIRIT OF JEHOVAH** caused him to rest; so You led Your people, to make a glorious name for Yourself. <sup>15</sup>Look down from Heaven and peer from the place of Your holiness and Your glory. Where *is* Your zeal and Your might? The roaring of Your bowels and Your mercies toward me, are they held back? <sup>16</sup>For You *are* **OUR FATHER**, though Abraham does not know us, and Israel does not acknowledge us; **YOU, JEHOVAH, are our FATHER**, our Redeemer; Your name is from everlasting.”

Who is this “ANGEL OF HIS FACE”?

In the scriptures that follow, we will meet this “Angel” with different names, such as “the Angel of God”, “the Angel of His face”, “the Angel of His presence”, and “the Angel of Jehovah”. Is He an angel by nature, in other words, is he a created angel, or is He something more than they? Let us read the following verses:

#### **Genesis 16:6-14**

“<sup>6</sup>But Abram said to Sarai, See, your slave girl *is* in your hand. Do to her what is good in your eyes. And Sarai dealt harshly with her, and she fled from before her. <sup>7</sup>And the ANGEL OF JEHOVAH found her by a well of water in the wilderness; by the well in the way of Shur. <sup>8</sup>And He said, Hagar, Sarai's slave-girl, where did you come from? And where do you go? And she said, I am fleeing from the face of my mistress, Sarai. <sup>9</sup>And THE ANGEL OF JEHOVAH said to her, Return to your mistress and submit yourself under her hand. <sup>10</sup>And THE ANGEL OF JEHOVAH SAID TO HER, I WILL EXCEEDINGLY MULTIPLY YOUR SEED, so that it shall not be numbered for multitude. <sup>11</sup>And THE ANGEL OF JEHOVAH SAID TO HER, Behold! You *are* with child and shall bear a son; and you shall call his name Ishmael, because Jehovah has listened to your affliction. <sup>12</sup>And he shall be a wild ass of a man, his hand against all, and the hand of everyone against him; and he shall live before all his brothers. <sup>13</sup>And SHE CALLED THE NAME OF JEHOVAH, THE ONE SPEAKING TO HER, YOU, A GOD OF VISION! For she said, Even here have I looked after the One seeing me? <sup>14</sup>On account of this, the well was called, the Well of the Living One Seeing me. Behold, *it is* between Kadesh and Bered.”

The above verses testify that **THE ANGEL OF JEHOVAH** who spoke to Hagar in the wilderness, **IS JEHOVAH!** When Hagar called Him “Jehovah”, He did not correct her as the angel of Revelation 22:8,9 corrected John when he tried to bow down before him! Neither would a created angel have the authority to say to her, “**I WILL EXCEEDINGLY MULTIPLY YOUR SEED.**” Surely, according to these verses, the “Angel of Jehovah” is Jehovah!

#### **Genesis 31:10-13**

“<sup>10</sup>And it happened at the time the flock was in heat, I lifted up my eyes and saw in a dream: And behold! The rams leaping on the flock were striped, speckled, and spotted. <sup>11</sup>And THE ANGEL OF GOD SPOKE TO ME in a dream, Jacob! And I said, Behold me. <sup>12</sup>And He said, Lift up your eyes and see all the rams leaping on the flock; they are striped, speckled and spotted. For I have seen all that Laban is doing to you. <sup>13</sup>**I AM THE GOD OF BETHEL**, there where you anointed the pillar, where **YOU VOWED A VOW TO ME**. Now rise up; go out of this land and go back to the land of your kindred.”

From the above verses, we see again that “**THE ANGEL OF GOD**” is not a created angel but **GOD!**

#### **Zechariah 3:1,2**

“<sup>1</sup>And he made me see Joshua the high priest standing before **THE ANGEL OF JEHOVAH**, and Satan standing at his right hand to accuse him. <sup>2</sup>**AND JEHOVAH SAID TO SATAN, JEHOVAH REBUKE YOU, SATAN!** And, Jehovah who has chosen Jerusalem rebuke you! Is this not a brand

plucked out of the fire?”

Wow! Jehovah said, “Jehovah rebuke you”? Definitely, **THE ANGEL OF JEHOVAH IS JEHOVAH!**

### **Exodus 3:2-6**

“<sup>2</sup>And **THE ANGEL OF JEHOVAH APPEARED TO HIM IN A FLAME OF FIRE FROM THE MIDDLE OF A THORN BUSH.** And he looked, and behold, the thorn bush *was* burning with fire, and the thorn bush *was* not burned up! <sup>3</sup>And Moses said, I will turn aside now and see this great sight, why the thorn bush is not burned up. <sup>4</sup>And **JEHOVAH** saw that he turned aside to see, and **GOD** called to him from the midst of the thorn bush, and said, Moses! Moses! And he said, Behold me. <sup>5</sup>And He said, Do not come near here. Pull off your sandals from your feet, for the place on which you *are* standing *is* holy ground. <sup>6</sup>And **HE SAID, I AM THE GOD OF YOUR FATHERS, THE GOD OF ABRAHAM, THE GOD OF ISAAC, AND THE GOD OF JACOB. AND MOSES HID HIS FACE, FOR HE FEARED TO LOOK UPON GOD.**”

In the above verses, the “**Angel of Jehovah**” said to Moses that **He is God**. He did not say that He was God’s representative, but that **HE IS** the God of Abraham!

### **Exodus 23:20-23**

“<sup>20</sup>Behold, **I AM ABOUT TO SEND AN ANGEL BEFORE YOU, TO GUARD YOU IN THE WAY, AND TO BRING YOU TO THE PLACE WHICH I HAVE PREPARED.** <sup>21</sup>Be on guard before Him, and **LISTEN TO HIS VOICE.** Do not be rebellious against Him, **FOR HE WILL NOT FORGIVE YOUR TRANSGRESSIONS; FOR MY NAME IS IN HIM.** <sup>22</sup>For if you fully listen to His voice, and do all which I speak, I will be an enemy to *those* distressing you, and will be a foe to your foes. <sup>23</sup>**FOR MY ANGEL SHALL GO BEFORE YOU** and bring you in to the Amorite, and the Hittite, and the Perizzite, and the Canaanite, and the Hivite, and the Jebusite; and I will cut them off.” (Also, please check Exodus 17:6).

Who is this “**ANGEL**” who has the Name of God in Him, in other words, **who is called Jehovah, and who has the power to forgive sins? Who followed the Israelites in the desert?** Let us read 1 Corinthians 10:1-4. There, the apostle Paul explains that the One who followed the Israelites in the desert, was Christ:

“<sup>1</sup>And I do not want you to be ignorant, brothers, that our fathers were all under the cloud, and all passed through the Sea. <sup>2</sup>And all were baptized to Moses in the cloud, and in the Sea, <sup>3</sup>and all ate the same spiritual food. <sup>4</sup>And all drank the same spiritual drink; for they drank of **the spiritual rock following, and THAT ROCK WAS CHRIST.**”

### **Judges 13:18-22**

“<sup>18</sup>And **THE ANGEL OF JEHOVAH** said to him, Why do you ask this about My name? Yea, **it is WONDERFUL.** <sup>19</sup>And Manoah took the kid of the goats, and the food offering, and offered on the rock to Jehovah. And He did wonderfully, and Manoah and his wife *were* watching. <sup>20</sup>And it

happened as the flame from off the altar was going up to the heavens, that **THE ANGEL OF JEHOVAH** went up in the flame of the altar. And Manoah and his wife *were* watching. And they fell on their faces to the ground. <sup>21</sup>And **THE ANGEL OF JEHOVAH** did not appear any more to Manoah, or to his wife. **THEN MANOAH KNEW THAT HE WAS THE ANGEL OF JEHOVAH.** <sup>22</sup>And Manoah said to his wife, **DYING WE SHALL DIE, BECAUSE WE HAVE SEEN GOD.**

Who was this **ANGEL OF JEHOVAH** whose name was “**WONDERFUL**” (verse 18), and verse 22 calls Him “**GOD**”? Is it possible that someday this God would be born as a man? The prophet Isaiah sheds light on this question. Let us see what he wrote in Isaiah 9:6:

“For a Child is born; to us **A SON IS GIVEN**; and the government is on His shoulder; and His name is called **WONDERFUL**, Counselor, **THE MIGHTY GOD**, The Everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace.”

From the above verses we learn that the “**Angel of Jehovah**” is none else than **THE SON** who was **GIVEN** for our salvation (John 3:16), the Lord Jesus Christ! This “**ANGEL**” is not an angel by nature; in other words, He is not a created angel, but One of the True and Uncreated Godhead **YHWH** who was **SENT** by the Father (Isaiah 48:12-16 and Zechariah 2:8-11) as a Messenger because in both Hebrew and Greek, the word “**angel**”, means “**messenger**”.

The present study has provided us with more than enough evidence to realize that **THE ANGEL OF JEHOVAH** in the Old Testament is none else than Jehovah the **SON** who was God, the prehuman Jesus Christ (John 1:1,14; Philippians 2:6)! Therefore, when Isaiah 63:7-16 spoke of **THE FATHER** (verse 16), of the **ANGEL OF HIS FACE** (verse 9), and of **THE SPIRIT OF JEHOVAH** (verses 10,14), it actually spoke of the **FATHER**, of **THE SON** and of **THE HOLY SPIRIT**!

### **An Important Note**

Does the Old Testament even mention a Divine Person called “**SON**”? Let us read the following three verses:

#### **Isaiah 9:6**

“For a Child is born; to us **A SON** is given; and the government is on His shoulder; and His name is called Wonderful, Counselor, the Mighty God, The Everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace.”

#### **Psalms 2:12**

“**KISS** (love) **THE SON**, lest He be angry, and you perish *from* the way, when His wrath is kindled but a little. Oh the blessings of all those who **FLEE TO HIM FOR REFUGE!**”

#### **Proverbs 30:4**

“Who has gone up *to* Heaven, and come down? Who has gathered the wind in His fists? Who has bound the waters in *His* garments? Who has made all the ends of the earth to rise? What *is* His

name, and what *is* **HIS SON'S NAME**? Surely you know.”

After I examined all the above verses from the Old Testament, I concluded that although the word “Trinity” as such is not found in the Bible, the Triunity of the True Godhead was fully revealed in the Old Testament!

How about the New Testament? Does it reveal the Triunity of the Godhead? Let us pay attention to the following verses:

**Matthew 3:16,17**

“And having been baptized, **JESUS** went up immediately from the water. And, behold! The heavens were opened to Him, and He saw **THE SPIRIT OF GOD** coming down as a dove, and coming upon Him. And behold! **A VOICE OUT OF HEAVEN** (the **FATHER**) saying, This is My Son, the Beloved, in whom I have been delighting.”

**Matthew 28:19**

“Then having gone, disciple all nations, baptizing them into the name of **THE FATHER** and of **THE SON** and of **THE HOLY SPIRIT**,”

**2 Corinthians 13:14**

“The grace of **THE LORD JESUS CHRIST** and the love of **GOD** and the fellowship of **THE HOLY SPIRIT** *be* with you all. Amen.”

**Romans 5:5,6**

“And the hope does not put *us* to shame, because the love of **GOD** has been poured out in our hearts through *the* **HOLY SPIRIT** given to us; for we yet being without strength, in due time **CHRIST** died for ungodly ones.”

**John 16:13-15**

“But when that One comes, **THE SPIRIT OF TRUTH**, He will guide you into all Truth, for He will not speak from Himself, but whatever He hears, He will speak; and He will announce the coming things to you. **THAT ONE WILL GLORIFY ME (THE SON)**, for He will receive from Mine and will announce to you. All things which **THE FATHER** has are mine. For this reason I said that He receives from Mine, and will announce to you.”

**Ephesians 2:18**

“For through **HIM (the Son)** we both have access by one **SPIRIT** to **THE FATHER**.”

**Romans 8:11**

“But if **THE SPIRIT** of Him that raised up Jesus (**THE SON**) from the dead dwell in you, **HE THAT RAISED UP CHRIST FROM THE DEAD (THE FATHER)** shall also quicken your mortal bodies by His Spirit that dwelleth in you.”

**Hebrews 9:14**

“How much more shall the blood of **CHRIST** (the **SON**), who through the eternal **SPIRIT** offered himself without spot to **GOD** (the **FATHER**), purge your conscience from dead works to serve the living God?”

**Revelation 2:17,18**

“<sup>17</sup>The *one* who has an ear, hear what **THE SPIRIT** says to the assemblies. To the *one* overcoming, I will give him to eat from the hidden manna. And I will give to him a white stone, and on the stone a new name having been written, which no one knows except the *one* receiving it. <sup>18</sup>And to the angel of the assembly in Thyatira, write: These things says **THE SON of GOD**, the *One* having His eyes as a flame of fire, and His feet like burnished brass”.

The following two verses, together, reveal that when it comes to salvation, **THE FATHER DRAWS** the person **TO COME TO JESUS**, and **THE HOLY SPIRIT SEALS** him/her:

**John 6:44**

“No one is able to come **TO ME** (the **SON**) unless **THE FATHER** who sent Me draws him, and I will raise him up in the last day.”

**Ephesians 4:30**

“And do not grieve **THE HOLY SPIRIT OF GOD, BY WHOM YOU WERE SEALED** to the day of redemption.”

All the above New Testament verses, reveal the Triune God!

The present study, proved beyond any doubt that although the word “**TRINITY**” does not exist in the Bible, the concept and the truth of it does in both the Old and New Testaments!
